

Our Finances

Mary's Place by the Sea provides two-night retreats, day retreats and virtual services to women with cancer. Since our founding, we have never had to charge a guest a single dollar to participate in our program. All accommodations, meals and services are provided at NO COST to our guests, thanks to the generosity of our Mary's Place by the Sea community. How Can You Help?



Donate

72 cents of every dollar directly supports our guests with services, meals and accommodations that help them on their road to healing: mind, body and soul. We receive support largely through individual donations, corporate support and foundation grants. We also gladly accept matching gifts from employers.



Volunteer

This year, 3,409 volunteer hours were dedicated directly to helping our guests in our home. This translates to a \$118,599.11 cost savings in New Jersey, where the current value of a volunteer hour is estimated to be \$34.79.
