Mary's Place by the Sea Sets Participation Record, Raises \$220,000 at 14th Annual Walk-A-Thon/ 7th Annual 5k Run to Provide Healing Services to Women with Cancer

OCEAN GROVE, N.J., Oct. 22, 2025 – <u>Mary's Place by the Sea</u>, a nonprofit offering wellness retreats and services for women with cancer, set a new participation record at its 14th Annual Walk-A-Thon/7th Annual 5k Run on Oct. 18, 2025. Over 1,500 participants walked and ran in Mary's Place's largest fundraiser, helping to raise \$220,000 to provide women with cancer integrative services to heal their mind, body and soul. This was the largest number of participants to join the event since it began, surpassing the organization's fundraising goal of \$200,000.

Founded in 2009, Mary's Place by the Sea has served over 16,000 women with cancer, offering complimentary overnight stays and day visits that include personalized services for the mind, body and soul, including oncology massage, health coaching and reiki at its custom-built home in Ocean Grove, N.J. Virtual services are also available before and after cancer treatment. All services, private accommodations and meals are provided at NO COST to guests.

"This year's Annual Walk-A-Thon & 5K Run was our largest ever, giving us the opportunity to provide more services to more women with cancer," said Executive Director and Founder Michele Gannon, Mary's Place by the Sea. "The support of our community, former guests and volunteers is truly tremendous. As the rates of cancer have increased, so has the need for the experience Mary's Place offers to help women during their healing journey. The funds raised will give women with cancer the chance to rest, relax and connect with others who understand their cancer journey."

Along the shores of the Atlantic Ocean on Ocean Pathway, the event began with an opening ceremony and ended with a vendor market, food vendors and trucks, and live music from the Pat Roddy Band. This year's Annual Walk-A-Thon & 5K Run had 43 teams and 350 individual fundraisers participate.
